## OUR STORY



Lunch and Learn Hosts are responsible for setting up a meeting room space, providing lunch, and promoting the event within the company.

## INTERNET SAFETY TRAINER

Our Internet Safety programs are multi-media presentations provided to children, teens, and parents - each group has its own safety education component, interactive computer screens, handouts, and child identification kits.

Presenters must undergo a three-hour training and be flexible in time and location for presentations.
