- 1. Call the TEXSAR activation line: 512-994-4SAR (4727).
- 2. Information will be requested from the requesting agency.
- 3. TEXSAR works directly with the requesting agency to gather
- information to establish TEXSAR's response plan and mission role. 4.TEXSAR deploys.
