

Beginning July 14, fans can pledge a donation to Texas Center for the Missing. At the end of the tournament, funds will be tallied up based on flat donations and the number of birdies made. The three organizations that raise the most money (plus one randomly selected organization) will win a special bonus. Texas Center for the Missing will receive all of the dollars we raise at the end of the program so bid on those Birdies!



HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE IN BIRDIES FOR CHARITY®?

Starting July 14, there are two ways to donate to the Birdies for Charity program:

1. Make a pledge of one cent or more for every “Birdie” made by the PGA Tour Pros during the Houston Open. If 1,500 birdies are made during the 2021 event, here are the totals for some typical pledge amounts:

- 1 cent pledge = \$15 total pledge
- 3 cent pledge = \$45 total pledge
- 10 cent pledge = \$150 total pledge
- \$1.00 pledge = \$1,500 total pledge

The minimum birdie pledge is \$.01 and the maximum pledge is \$1.00.

- In 2019, 1,244 birdies were made
- In 2020, 1,221 birdies were made

2. Make a flat donation not tied to birdies. For flat donations, the minimum is \$20.
